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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Russell W. Glidden, of Gardiner.**

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**Russell W. Glidden; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$181.54 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Russell W. Glidden, of Gardiner, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident happened on June 28, 1945 around 12 P. M. while Mr. Glidden was driving through the town of Eddington. A deer jumped from the woods and crashed into the car causing damage to the extent of \$181.54. Game Warden Thomas Sprague investigated.
