RESOLVE, in Favor of Everett York, of Otisfield.

Everett York; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$210 to be paid to Everett York, of R. F. D. No. 1, Oxford, as a full and final settlement of all claims for damage to his horse by a moose.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The horse was found in an Otisfield pasture on November 4, with a broken leg. Dr. S. S. Greenleaf of Bethel examined the horse and advised that it be killed. In the opinion of Mr. York and Dr. Greenleaf, the horse had been attacked and gored by a bull moose.
