RESOLVE, in Favor of Berry Hill Orchard Company, of Livermore.

Berry Hill Orchard Company; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,285.08 from the appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to Berry Hill Orchard Company, of Livermore, as a full and final settlement for their claim against the state for damage to their apple orchard by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This damage was done during 1945 and 1946.

Attempts were made to prevent damage to the orchard by use of repellants. Deer continued to do damage, which was regularly reported to the department of inland fisheries and game. Damage was investigated by Game Warden Pearl Neidler who inspected and determined percentage of damage to each tree.
