RESOLVE, in Favor of Andrew Arsenault, of Skowhegan.

Andrew Arsenault; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$269.60 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Andrew Arsenault, of Skowhegan, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his truck by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on November 25, 1946, in Skowhegan, and was investigated by Game Warden Milton Scribner. The truck was damaged considerably about the front end and was towed to a garage.
