**RESOLVE, in Favor of Desmond A. Beatty, of Augusta.**

---

**Desmond A. Beatty; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$500 from the appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to Desmond A. Beatty, of Augusta, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his apple orchard at East Otisfield by deer.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This damage was done during the years 1944, 1945 and 1946. This matter was taken up with the department of inland fisheries and game with very unsatisfactory results. The department of agriculture valued these trees at \$10 apiece due to loss of fruit and growth of trees, however, the department of inland fisheries and game set their value at \$5, therefore Mr. Beatty is making his claim as follows:

100 trees @ \$5 ..... \$500
