RESOLVE, in Favor of the Civil Air Patrol.

Civil Air Patrol; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$25,000 from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to be expended by the Civil Air Patrol for an expansion of its training program.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Civil Air Patrol requests \$25,000 for a greater expansion of its vital training program. This money, although far from adequate for its complete needs, will permit CAP to purchase surplus war equipment. Purchase of this equipment is available on high priority at discount. CAP needs, badly, equipment for instruction in aircraft engines, radio mechanics and other courses and for setting up a state-wide radio network; also for obtaining surplus real property in which to house training classes and equipment. Also funds are needed to pay for meals and transportation to and from encampments.
