STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Judge and Recorder of the Bath Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1937, c. 64, amended. That part designated "Sec. 2." of chapter 64 of the private and special laws of 1937, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 'Sec. 2. Qualifications of judge and recorder; salary. Said judge shall be a member of the bar of Sagadahoc county, and shall reside during his continuance in office in said county. The judge of said court shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of \$2,000 to be paid to him in quarterly payments. The recorder shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of \$1,100 to be paid to him in quarterly payments. Both salaries shall be in full for all fees and emoluments of their respective offices.'
