AN ACT Relating to Income Accruing to the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 15, § 8, amended. The 1st sentence of section 8 of chapter 15 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘It shall be the duty of the treasurer of state to receive and keep a record of all items of income accruing to the state **and not paid within 90 days,** including taxes levied by the state, and all such items shall be promptly certified to the treasurer of state by the department, bureau, institution, or agency of state government where such items of income originate or by which such taxes are assessed.’
