AN ACT Relating to Disposition of Uncollectible Accounts Due the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 30, amended. Section 30 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 30. Charging off of accounts due the state. The controller shall charge off the books of account of the state or of any department, institution, or agency thereof, such accounts receivable, including all taxes for the assessment or collection of which the state is responsible, and all impounded bank accounts, as shall be certified to him as impractical of realization by or for said state, department, institution, or agency; said certification to be by the commissioner of finance ~~and state auditor~~ and subject to the approval of the governor **and council**; provided, however, that in each such case, the charging off of such accounts shall be recommended by the head of the department, institution, or agency originally responsible for such account.'
