### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Patten for Support and Care of Children of Howard Stubbs.

Town of Patten; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$2121.68 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Patten, to reimburse said town for support and care of 4 children of Howard Stubbs who were committed into the custody of the state; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

These 4 children were committed into the custody of the state on August 5, 1939 and the cost of their support and care was billed to the town of Patten from that time until they were dismissed from the custody of the state, as shown in the resolve above.
