IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Grover C. Small, of Deer Isle.

Grover C. Small; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$109.82 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Grover C. Small, of Deer Isle, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on November 18, 1946, in Deer Isle, and was investigated by Game Warden Clinton H. Barrett. The whole front end of the car was damaged.
