RESOLVE, in Favor of Liston C. Bean, of Bryants Pond.

Liston C. Bean; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$112.55 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Liston C. Bean, of Bryants Pond, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on June 18, 1945 around 8.45 P. M., in Milton Plantation, and was investigated by Game Warden Leon M. Wilson. Mr. Bean's car was damaged to the extent of: Grill broken; left headlight and left fog light broken; left front fender badly bent, also left side of hood; radiator punctured.
