Jesse N. Mills; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$114.05 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Jesse N. Mills, of Southwest Harbor, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on January 2, 1946, around 11:30 P. M. in Bar Harbor, and was investigated by game warden Lyle E. Smith. The extent of the damage is as follows: right front fender badly damaged; radiator damaged; grille will have to be replaced.
