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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Dr. P. F. M. Gilley, of Southwest Harbor.**

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**Dr. P. F. M. Gilley; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$141 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Dr. P. F. M. Gilley, of Southwest Harbor, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by deer.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Dr. Gilley's car, which was driven by Phillip Gilley, Jr., was damaged considerably when it struck a deer on September 13, 1946, around 2:30 A. M. in the town of Bar Harbor. Game warden Lyle E. Smith was notified and investigated the accident.
