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**AN ACT Relating to Appeal from Orders for Judging Dangerous  
Buildings to be Nuisances.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 128, § 25, amended.** Section 25 of chapter 128 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 25. Owner may apply to supreme judicial or superior court.** Any owner aggrieved by such order may **within 10 days after said order is so made and filed**, apply to a justice of the supreme judicial or superior court, in term time or vacation, who shall forthwith, after notice and hearing, affirm, annul or alter such order. If the court is not in session, the action shall be entered on the docket of the preceding term.'
