IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, for the Construction of a Dyke in the Town of Howland.

Construction of dyke; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$16,000 from the general highway fund for the construction of a dyke, in the town of Howland, approximately 1,000 feet long and extending along the east bank of the Piscataquis river about 800 feet from the highway bridge, thence to the Milo road through the property of the Atlas Plywood Company; said construction to be under the supervision of the highway department. •

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STATEMENT OF FACTS

This dyke is to be constructed under the supervision of the state highway commission and the materials, such as sand, gravel, etc. and damage costs, is to be borne by the town of Howland. The estimated cost will be \$16,000.
