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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Blanche Griffin, of Kingman.**

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**Blanche Griffin; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$130.83 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Blanche Griffin, of Kingman, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state for damage to her car by a deer.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

A deer jumped in front of B. Griffin's car causing damage to the extent of \$105.83. The car had to be towed for 50 miles at a cost of \$25. This accident happened on September 9, 1946 in the town of Lincoln, and was investigated by Game Warden Clyde Speed.
