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**RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Penobscot County to Carl J. Kennedy of Milford.**

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**State tax assessor authorized to convey certain land. Resolved:** That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Carl J. Kennedy, of Milford, whatever interest the state has in lot in lot 41, River lot 9, bounded N. by Ernest Ladd and Winfield Spencer, E. by Penobscot river, S. by town land, W. by Leroy Weymouth, with buildings, in Argyle township, Penobscot county, containing 68 acres, more or less, for the sum of \$127.81.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This tract of land was sold November 25, 1942 for the 1940 taxes. Carl J. Kennedy wishes to purchase this property for the sum of \$127.81 which is the amount of back taxes, interest and cost. This amount has been deposited with the treasurer of state.
