STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to School Committee in Town of Rumford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1935, c. 48, § 2, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 2 of chapter 48 of the private and special laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The governing boards and officers of the town, to be balloted upon and elected by the qualified voters at the annual town meeting as hereinafter provided, shall be: A board of 5 selectmen, who shall be ex officio overseers of the poor, a superintending school committee of 3 5, a board of assessors of 3, a tax collector, town treasurer and a town clerk.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1935, c. 48, § 2, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 2 of chapter 48 of the private and special laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'As the members of the superintending school committee are now elected each for a 3 year term, those whose term has not expired when this act, as amended, shall take effect shall continue to serve until their term expires. and only the vacancies shall be filled at the 1st election hereunder. Thereafter, ** member shall be elected each year for a term of 3 years.

One member of said superintending school committee At the 1st annual town meeting after this act, as amended, shall take effect, 3 members shall The 2 persons receiving the be elected to the said school committee. highest number of votes shall serve for a term of 3 years and the person receiving the next highest number of votes shall serve for a term of 2 years and thereafter at each annual town meeting only the necessary number of members of the committee shall be elected as may be required to maintain the full membership of the committee at 5 and each shall serve for 3 years. One member of said committee shall be a resident of that part of Rumford which lies outside of the limits of the Rumford Falls Village Corporation, and 2 members shall be residents of that part of Rumford which lies within the said limits of the Rumford Falls Village Corporation and 2 members shall be elected from the town of Rumford at large. No more than 3 members of said committee shall serve as members of the joint school committee. The chairman of said local committee shall be a member of the joint school committee, and the other 2 members of the joint school committee shall be elected by the majority vote of the members of the local school committee.'
