STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Maintenance of Ways Already Laid Out Which Cross Over or Under Railroad Tracks and Not at Grade.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 84, § 48, amended. Section 48 of chapter 84 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 17 of chapter 293 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 48. Maintenance of ways already laid out. In Notwithstanding the provisions of any section of chapter 41 of the revised statutes in case of such ways already laid out, which cross over or under any railroad track or tracks, and not at grade, the allocation of the expense of rebuilding, reconstructing and maintaining so much thereof as is within the limits of such railroad shall be determined, do novo, as provided by the preceding section, by the public utilities commission upon application to it by any corporation whose track is, or tracks are, so crossed, or upon application by the municipal officers of any town in which the crossing is located or upon application by the state highway commission.'
