STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the University of Maine,

University of Maine; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the University of Maine the sum of \$35,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948, and the sum of \$35,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949 for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a law school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The University of Maine formerly conducted a law school. A law school is needed in Maine so that our boys and girls may receive a legal education within the confines of their own state. The Maine State Bar Association voted at its meeting held January 8, 1947 to recommend the reestablishing of the Maine Law School.
