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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Roy R. Bell, of Thomaston.**

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**Roy R. Bell; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$658 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Roy R. Bell, of Thomaston, for lost time, travel and attorney's fees.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

On March 13, 1946, Roy R. Bell was dismissed by the warden of the State Prison at Thomaston, without hearing. On April 5, 1946, after hearing, the Personnel Board held the dismissal unwarranted, and Mr. Bell was reinstated on May 19, 1946 to same position at the State Prison at Thomaston.
