## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to the Bangor Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1895, c. 211, § 11, amended. The 1st sentence of section 11 of chapter 211 of the private and special laws of 1895, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Said court shall be held at such place as the city of Bangor shall provide and said city shall have power and it shall be its duty to raise money to provide a proper place for said court and its officers and suitably furnish, warm and light the same, for which there shall be paid from the county of Penobscot, as rental, in quarterly payments, the sum of one thousand dollars \$2,500 annually, said rental to begin January 1, 1947.'
