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**AN ACT Relating to Conveyance of Elementary School Pupils.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 37, § 8, amended.** Section 8 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following provision: **Provided, also, that when any town does not provide schools for all children within the town, and such children attend in the same or a neighboring town a privately maintained school which is not operated for profit, and which is accepted by the State Commissioner of Education as a satisfactory substitute for the public school, the children attending such private school may ride on established public school busses with the same rights as the pupils in the public schools.**
