STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Conveyance of Elementary School Pupils.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following provision: Provided, also, that when any town does not provide schools for all children within the town, and such children attend in the same or a neighboring town a privately maintained school which is not operated for profit, and which is accepted by the State Commissioner of Education as a satisfactory substitute for the public school, the children attending such private school may ride on established public school busses with the same rights as the pupils in the public schools.
