AN ACT Relating to Counsel Fees in Divorce Proceedings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 153, § 59, amended. Section 59 of chapter 153 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that if the libel is dismissed after any such order for payment of counsel fees for prosecution is made and paid, no further counsel fees for prosecution shall be ordered paid upon a libel brought within 1 year after such dismissal.'
