**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for Smelts in Tidewaters of East Machias
Branch of Machias River.**

Tidewaters of East Machias branch of Machias river; fishing for smelts regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation creating an open time in which it shall be lawful to fish for and take smelts from the tidewaters of the East Machias branch of the Machias river within the town limits of Machiasport, between the 1st day of October and the 1st day of May.

Any fish so taken from said waters may be offered for sale and sold within the state or shipped to such places out of the state as the owner may designate.
