IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Penobscot County to Nelson Myrick of Lowell.

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Nelson Myrick, of Lowell, whatever interest the state has in a lot with buildings, bounded as follows: Beginning at S. W. corner of John Myrick house lot; thence W. parallel with N. line of said township, about 13 chains to a post; thence N. to supposed S. line of John Myrick 20 acre lot; thence E. along said S. line and parellel with N. line of said township, to S. E. corner of said 20-acre lot; thence S. along W. line of said John Myrick house lot to point of beginning, in T. I North Division, Penobscot county, containing 22 acres, more or less, for the sum of \$35.18.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This tract was sold November 25, 1942 for the 1940 taxes. Nelson Myrick wishes to purchase this property for the sum of \$35.18 which is the amount of back taxes, interest and cost. This amount has been deposited with the Treasurer of State.
