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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Clayton Tucker, of Cherryfield.**

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**Clayton Tucker; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$101.34 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Clayton Tucker, of Cherryfield, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Tucker's car, which was driven by Charlotte Tucker, on October 19, 1946, in Deblois, was damaged to the extent of a broken fan, radiator, fan and head light, when a deer jumped in front of the car. Game Warden Raymon Harrington investigated the accident.
