STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Clerks in the County Offices of Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to Knox county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Knox county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$\frac{\pi_1}{1},040\$ \$2,620; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$\frac{\pi_32}{2}\$ \$1,920; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$\frac{\pi_1}{1},040\$ \$2,320; for clerk hire in the office of the county treasurer, \$180.'
