RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Virginia Lake.

Fishing in Virginia Lake; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Virginia lake in the town of Stoneham, county of Oxford, to all fishing except fly fishing.
