IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Charles H. Buck, of Naples.

Charles H. Buck; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,531.25 to be paid to Charles H. Buck, of Naples, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for young birds, hens and roosters killed by coons and foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.
