STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Fort Fairfield for Support of Omar Michaud and Family.

Town of Fort Fairfield; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$2,674.64 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Fort Fairfield, to reimburse said town for support of Omar Michaud and family, state paupers; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

From the first application by Mr. Michaud for pauper supplies until the case finally was closed, the town of Fort Fairfield expended a total of \$2,674.64 for which it has not received reimbursement from any source. Receipted bills for this amount are on file at the town office in Fort Fairfield. There were two apparently conflicting court decisions on the question of Mr. Michaud's place of legal settlement.
