RESOLVE, in Favor of Evelyn K. Foye, of Westbrook.

Evelyn K. Foye; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$310 to be paid to Evelyn K. Foye, of Westbrook, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state for injuries received while being in a state liquor store as a customer; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On November 13, 1946, while making a purchase in the state liquor store in Westbrook, Mrs. Foye tripped on a mat 4 feet by 6 feet in dimensions and 1 inch high, inside said store, breaking her right shoulder; consequently, was incapacitated for a period of 6 weeks.
