RESOLVE, in Favor of Alice Richardson of Aurora.

Alice Richardson; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$385.12 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Alice Richardson, of Aurora, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state for damage done to the car of her late husband, Herbert Richardson, by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on November 19, 1944, in Amherst, and was investigated by Game Warden Hollis B. Patterson. The Chevrolet 2-door sedan, driven by Herbert Richardson, now deceased, was badly damaged. Mrs. Richardson is requesting that she be reimbursed for the above amount.
