AN ACT Relating to Conveyance of Pupils.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 8-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 8-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 8-A. Conveyance of pupils residing more than 1 mile from school. Any youth of school age residing in any incorporated town or plantation within the state, and more than 1 mile from any school in such town or plantation, must be conveyed to and from such school. Such conveyance must be furnished by such town or plantation and conform to the standard rules and regulations which have been prescribed by the department of education relating to such conveyance.’
