**AN ACT Governing the Regulations for Traveling Amusement Shows
and Circuses.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 88, § 53-A, additional. Chapter 88 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 53-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 53-A. Insurance commissioner to promulgate rules and regulations. The insurance commissioner shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations relative to fire protection, fire prevention and accident prevention governing such circuses and traveling amusement shows.'
