STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Permitting Towns to Appropriate Money for State Aid Roads in Anticipation of State Appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 109, amended. Section 109 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following: 'Provided, however, that the state highway commission may at any time, from appropriate funds, reimburse towns for expenditures previously made for the improvement of state aid roads, provided such expenditures have been made with the consent of the state highway commission and under its supervision, and that such reimbursements in any year shall not exceed the apportionments made to such towns for the improvement of state aid roads under existing statute.'
