STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Reimbursing Towns for Tuition for Pupils Attending Secondary Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 99, amended. Section 99 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 93 and by section 2 of chapter 120 and by chapter 199, all of the public laws of 1945; and repealed and replaced by section 36 of chapter 378 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the 1st paragraph thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'The commissioner shall reimburse such towns for the full amount thus paid by such town for such occupational course.'
