RESOLVE, in Favor of Don McCrum, Jr., of Presque Isle.

Don McCrum, Jr.; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$199.33 to be paid to Don McCrum, Jr., of Presque Isle, as a full and final settlement of all claims against the state for damage to his car by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident occurred on October 16, 1946, at 6 P. M. in the town of LaGrange, Route 11. Mr. McCrum's radiator was demolished and driven back into the fan; left fender bent badly; both parking lights and both headlamps broken. This accident was investigated by Thomas W. Sprague.
