STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Improve the Approach to the Fish Way at Aroostook Falls.

Fish way at Aroostook Falls; improving the approach of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$3,000 to be taken from the general fund of the state and expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, for improving the approach to the fish way at Aroostook Falls on the Aroostook river in the Province of New Brunswick.

Any and all acts done in compliance with the provisions of this resolve in the Province of New Brunswick shall be with the consent and approval of said Province.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During periods of low water, the fish have a great deal of difficulty in reaching the lower end of the fish way and this improvement is desired for the purpose of making it possible for them to reach the fishway in all periods of the year.
