RESOLVE, in Favor of Lewis W. Philbrick, of Kenduskeag.

Lewis W. Philbrick; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$252.12 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Lewis W. Philbrick, of Kenduskeag, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on November 10, 1945, in Bangor, and was investigated by Game Warden T. W. Sprague. The car was badly damaged, the expense of parts to replace those broken amounting to \$125.37, and the labor to repair the damage amounting to \$126.75.
