STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the City of Biddeford.

City of Biddeford; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,530 from the general fund of the state to be paid to the city of Biddeford as full and final settlement for its claim for reimbursement of the state's quota of the salary and expense paid by the city of Biddeford to its superintendent of schools for the 1944 school year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Prior to the effective date of 1945 Private and Special Laws, Chapter 124, changing the charter provisions of the city of Biddeford, permitting it to join a school union to which it has belonged since said effective date, the contract with the superintendent of schools was subject to the control of a superintending school committee elected by the voters of Biddeford by virtue of charter passed in 1933. In reliance upon the policy of the state from 1933 to 1943, inclusive, and many years prior thereof, the city paid its superintendent the amount claimed and in 1944, no refund by the state was made.
