**RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to John Smith of Caswell Plantation.**

---

**John Smith; pension for. Resolved:** That a pension of \$30 per month be, and hereby is, granted to John Smith, of Caswell Plantation, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1948 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Smith is 63 years of age. He is a cripple with no means of support. His wife also has no means of support.
