STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for John Gravel of Ridlonville.

John Gravel; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to John Gravel, of Ridlonville, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1947 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Gravel is incapacitated by reason of total paralysis of both legs and partial paralysis of urinary sphincter muscle. This is the result of his being hit by a moving automobile in May 1933. This information was given by J. A. MacDougall, M.D. of Rumford.
