STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Granting a Pension for Gilbert Bragdon, of Portage Lake.

Gilbert Bragdon; pension for. Resolved: That a pension of \$25 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Gilbert Bragdon, of Portage lake, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1947 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Bragdon was born in Portage on May 24, 1887. He has only one leg and lives with his mother, and their only means of support is \$40 per month she receives from old age assistance. He has no relatives able to help him, and the town has furnished him with doctor's care.
