RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Neville N. Faulkner, of Houlton.

Neville N. Faulkner; pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$30 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Neville N. Faulkner, of Houlton, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Said pension shall begin July 1, 1948, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

That part of chapter 77 of the resolves of 1939, which provides for a state pension for Neville N. Faulkner, of Houlton, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Faulkner was granted a pension of \$10 per month in 1939. According to a certificate signed by John R. Webber, M.D., Mr. Faulkner's right arm is amputated at shoulder, scar on lower lip where lip carcinoma was removed, hearing very poor in both ears, vision of eyes 20/50. This man is unable to properly support himself.
