STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Recorder of Eastport Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1915, c. 34, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 34 of the private and special laws of 1915 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Salary of recorder; fees, when paid. The recorder of the East-port municipal court shall receive as compensation an annual salary of one hundred dollars \$200, payable quarterly, from the county treasury of the county of Washington, on the 1st days of January, April, July and October. All fees collected by him shall be paid over to the county treasurer.'
