STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing the Salaries of the Judge and Clerk and Clerk Hire of the Bangor Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1895, c. 211, § 11, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 11 of chapter 211 of the private and special laws of 1895, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The salaries of the judge and clerk thereof, which are hereby fixed at $\frac{2}{2,700}$ \$3,300 and $\frac{2}{2,500}$ \$3,000, respectively, to be paid monthly, with all other expenses of said court, shall be paid from the treasury of the county of Penobscot, and in addition thereto there shall be provided the sum of $\frac{1}{51,800}$ \$2,500 per year for clerk hire, to be paid monthly from said treasury; provided, however, that the county commissioners of said county may in their discretion expend a larger amount, not exceeding $\frac{5}{500}$ \$1,500 per year, for the employment of extra clerks; payments of said salaries and said clerk hire to begin January 1, 1947.'
