**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Aroostook County to Burton Porter of Mapleton.**

---

**Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved:** That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Burton Porter, of Mapleton, whatever interest the state has in Camp Lot 13 M and Camp Lot 12 L in Public Lot #2 in Winterville plantation, Aroostook county, as per survey of Harry G. Tingley, dated September 7, 1944, and on file in the forest commissioner's office, for a sum to be agreed upon by the forest commissioner, Burton Porter and the town officials of Winterville plantation.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

A certain portion of these lots have been set aside for camp lots and Mr. Porter has a camp on one of them. Mr. Porter has the approval of the town officials.
